# Strategies to Support Online Learning Engagement

- Expand attendance-taking capabilities to keep track of every student regardless of their physical location
- Institute protocol to deliver laptops, textbooks and resources to affected student populations
- Demonstrate community leadership by highlighting class schedules and participation expectations
- Implement consistent “video meeting” standards between teachers, students, families and support staff
- Carefully select an LMS that seamlessly integrates with the school or district’s SIS and is easy to access for users at any level
- Assign frequent and consistent low-stake assignments to keep students engaged and moving towards course completion
- Communicate! Empower learning communities with multi-level messaging tools that directly connect families to school via text, email or phone, so no one falls behind
- Seek out customizable tech tools that allow educators to guide class creativity and connection, and empowers students and parents to engage with technology in a more meaningful way
- Allow families, teachers and administrators to digitally fill out and submit any and all necessary paperwork, including enrollment forms, fees, and assignments remotely
- Establish a consistent and sustainable Instructional Delivery Plan for immediate use across the entire school or district
- Develop Instructional Delivery Plan training for educators that clearly illustrates expectations and benchmarks
- Create and deploy strategies that help maintain a positive staff culture
